- you will only have 3 days in class to work on this project... plan ahead to get with your partners to work on the project outside of class if needed this is NOT required.
- include your information sheet when you turn in your book
- ask early if you have questions or are confused... waiting until the day before it's due is NOT acceptable. Be accountable for YOUR grade.
